## Neighbourhood Watch

Are you concerned about crime in our neighbourhood? Are you looking for ways to increase community safety and awareness?

Why not help us establish an Emerald Woods Neighbourhood Watch (NW)? A NW would provide a communication network to report suspicious activity to your neighbours and the police and to keep track of police follow-up. A NW would also increase overall communication with police and provide access to police resources.

Establishing a NW is free and does not require much work, but would require active participation by our community. Also, only registered members would have access to crime notifications.

We are looking for volunteers to fill the following NW positons, which are required for it to operate:

1) A NW Coordinator – to administer the program and serve as the main point of contact with Ottawa Police;

2) Block Captains – to coordinate reports of suspicious activity from members and share the information via text and e-mail.
