AGM Planning

- Thus far, the Councillor's office has declined to oversee the election, despite the previous Councillor's office having taken on this role
- Re: potential increase in membership fees: Previous exec did not have Director's Insurance, or have the field booked for soccer on both the day of and the rain date
- If we fold, and cancel the liability insurance which we purchase from the City and which is grandfathered, we likely would not be allowed to purchase from the city again
- All agreed to invite police to AGM; will put this on the agenda and discuss further about the topic
- Kim will pull minutes from last year's AGM to create an agenda
- Suggestion to put call for volunteers in agenda
- Keely recommended increasing the cost of events
- Need to emphasize that planning events is a primary goal of the Association, and we need to be clear with the membership that if volunteers do not step forward, we cannot have events
- AGM should include a vote on the date for Fun Day in the Park 2024
- Association runs on donations
- Consider charge per driveway for yard sale
